Search for nearly 500 points of interest on the maps by typing a name or partial name and clicking go. Results appear directly below.

Use checkboxes to display or hide various categories of points on the map (nearly 500).

Sub-categories and individual listings of nearly 500 points can be expanded here. Clicking on a listing name will re-center the map and display the point. Clicking on the i-Info balloon will pull up a detailed info window for that point.

The maps include outlines of major civic buildings and facilities on university campuses.

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The Nav button toggles the Navigator Map from visible to invisible, depending on user preference.

Use the zoom bar to zoom in and out. Click and drag anywhere on the map to re-center the map.

Organized neighborhoods are labeled to aid newcomers.

The Navigator Map displays the entire viewable area of the map. The red box inside shows the area currently visible on screen.
